### AMP BANK'S PROBLEMATIC CODE

The JMA Parties have asked me to write to you regarding AMP Bank's problematic banking code. As AMP's Managing Director and Director of the Australian Bankers' Association, this is a subject you will be familiar with.

We refer you to the **bankinfo.com** website asserting the bank permitted dual contracting to exist. This allowed it to obtain commercial and financial advantages in dealings with customers and small businesses. You have been Managing Director of the bank since 2008 and throughout this period you withheld this information from customers, their lawyers and the courts.

Considering the evidence available, you must either accept responsibility for the bank's conduct or testify to both your and AMP Bank's non-involvement and disapproval of this deceptive dual contracting arrangement.
